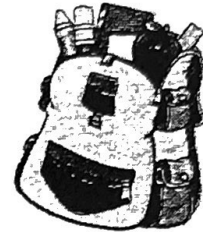


LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.



REQUIRED ITEMS:

- 1 book-bag (large enough for a pocket folder)
- 1 lunchbox
- 1 pack of #2 Ticonderoga pencils (pre-sharpened, if possible)
- Crayons (24 pack or smaller)
- Pencil box/soft case
- 6 **large** glue sticks
- 1 bottle of Elmer's Glue
- 6 **fat** dry erase markers (**BLACK** only)
- 2 black and white composition notebooks
- 2 twin pocket folders (plastic, if possible)
- 1 pair of headphones (over the head- **NOT** earbuds/wireless)
